RENATO DULBECCO EXCELLENCY AWARD

Renato Dulbecco (February 22, 1914 – February 19, 2012) was an Italian American, who won the 1975 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine for his work on oncoviruses, which are viruses that can cause cancer when they infect animal cells

Born in Italy in 1914, Renato Dulbecco was a virologist who won the Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine along with Howard M. Temin and David Baltimore. In the 1950s, the three men pioneered the growing of viruses in a culture, lending insight into cell growth. The research helped pave the way for studying cancer cells in the fight against cancer. Dulbecco died in 2012 in La Jolla, California.

ASIMA CHATTERJEE EXCELLENCY AWARD

Born on September 23, 1917, Asima Chatterjee, was one of the first Indian women to earn a doctorate in science in British India. She paved the way for Indian women to pursue organic chemistry and opened the world's eyes to the power of medicinal plants. Her most notable work includes research on vinca alkaloids, the development of anti-epileptic drugs, and development of anti-malarial drugs.

She also authored a considerable volume of work on medicinal plants of the Indian subcontinent. She graduated with honors in chemistry from the Scottish Church College of the University of Calcutta in 1936.. She was the first woman to receive a Doctorate of Science from an Indian university.
